This is Harry Barr's second show at this Gallery.

He is a Londoner and studied under Sickert. He painted largely in oils, using, like Sickert, watercolour as note for the latter, subsequently, however, using it as a medium in its own right.

Watercolour had always fascinated him and he became determined to rescue it from the neglect it had suffered for so long. He concentrated on the medium and succeeded in getting a one man invited show in it, at a major London Gallery in the Spring of 1965, showing 120 paintings — a very rare occurrence in recent years. Simultaneously with this exhibition he had an invited one man show in watercolour, in Moscow, where 80 paintings were shown for six weeks, eventually in the Spring of 1966, moving to Leningrad where it was also shown for 6 weeks, thus becoming the first English painter ever to have had one man shows of watercolours in Russia.

He also specialises in line drawing and had a one man show in the Bloomsbury art gallery in London after returning from Paris, where he worked for a considerable time before the war.
